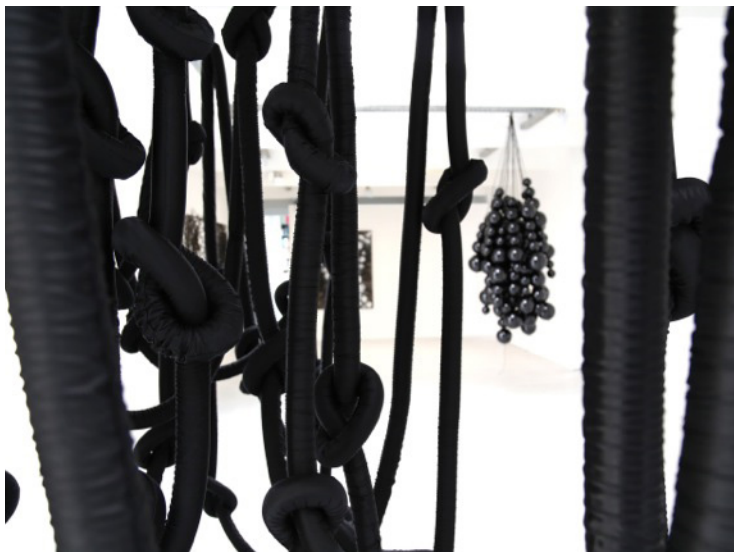
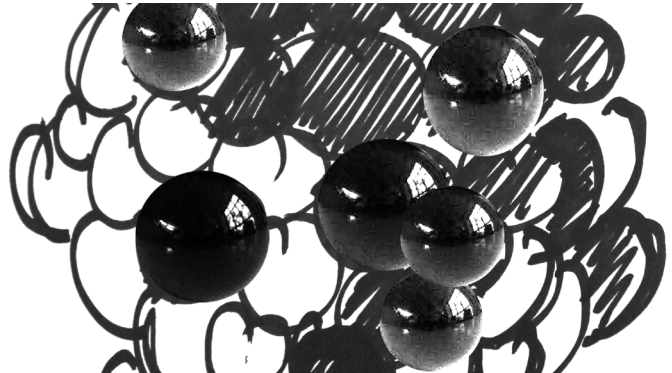


## *SOMNIFLOS - INNSBRUCK*

All spheres are suspended with black acrylic strings.





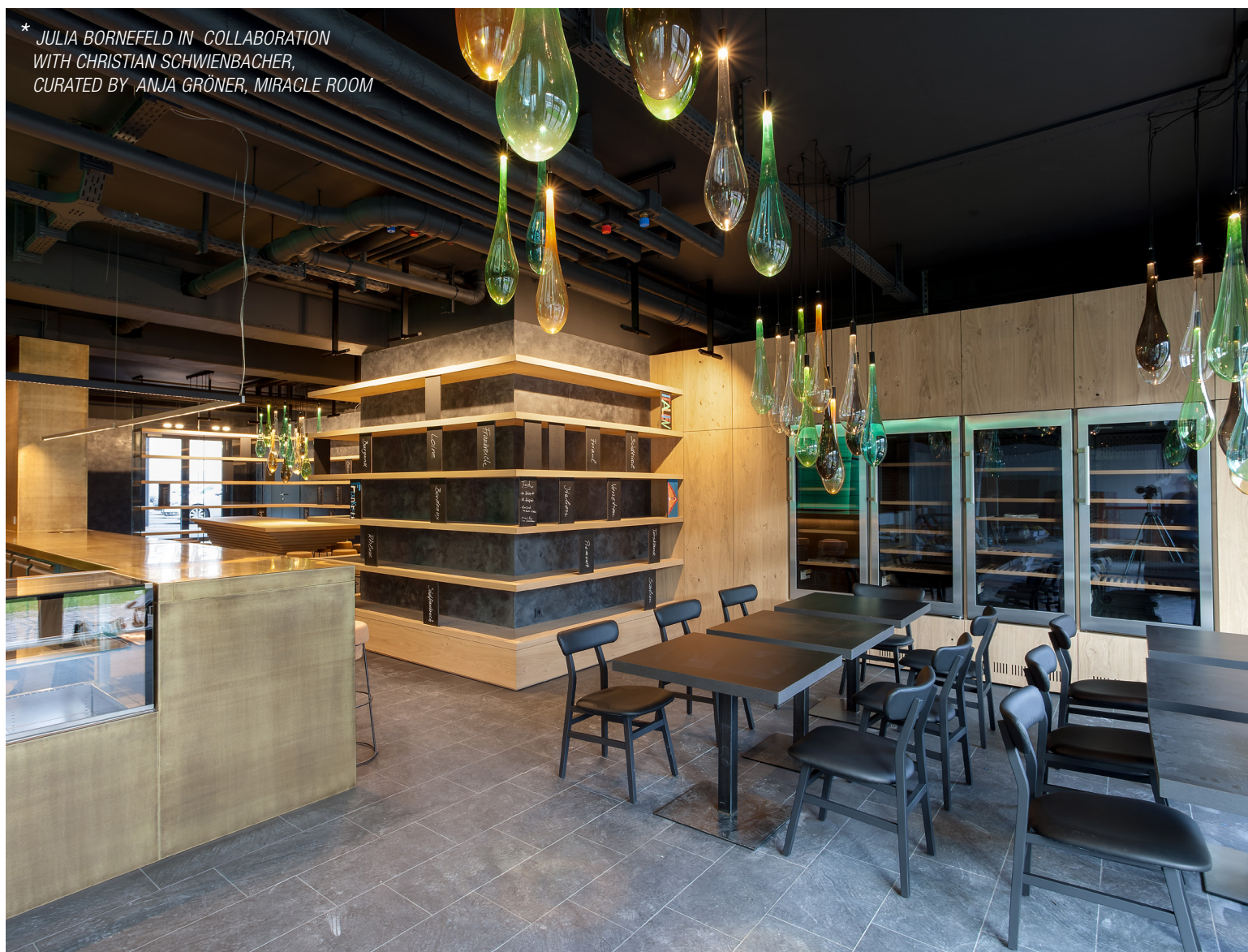
## CHÂTEAU 9 - LEIPZIG\*

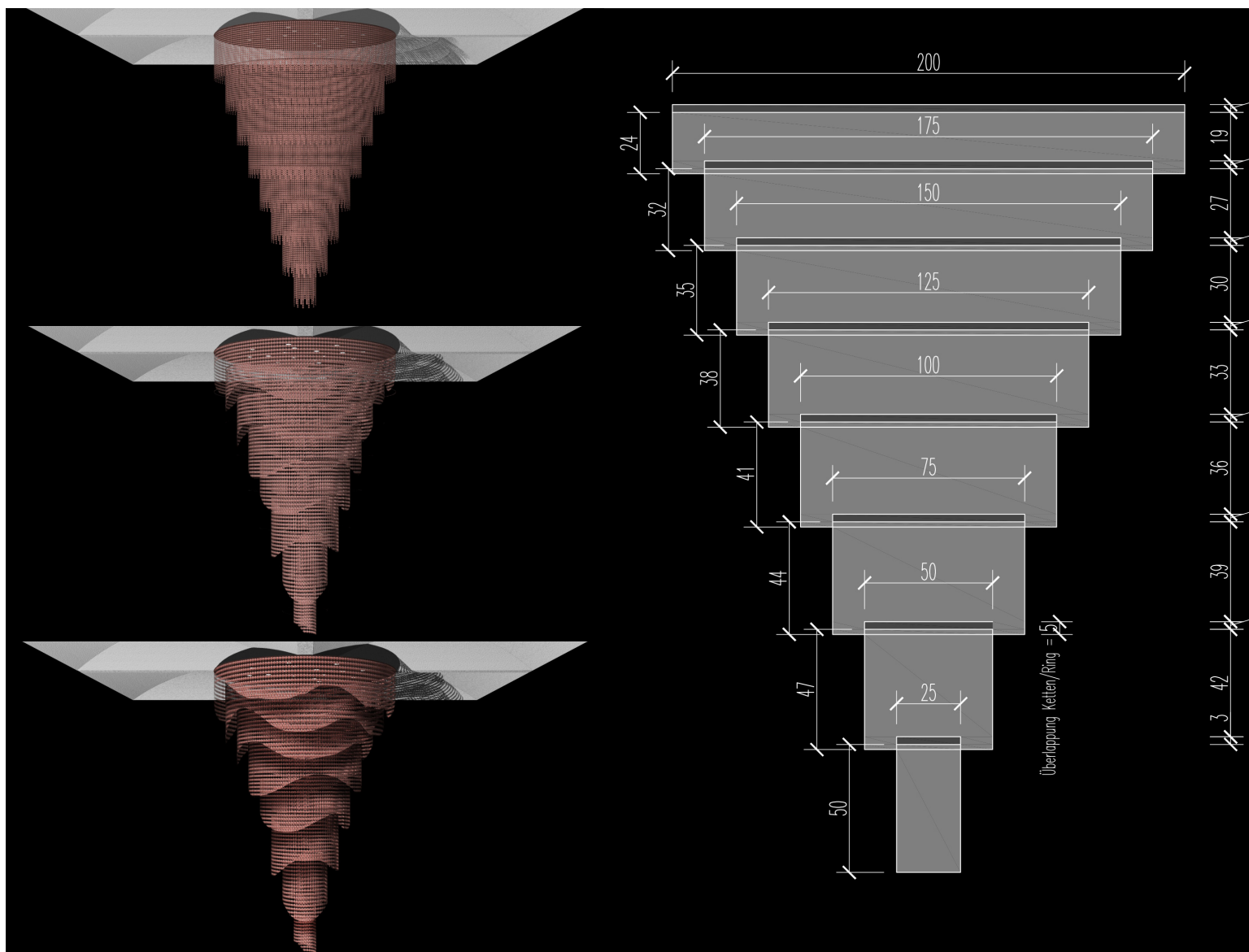
## EPHEMERE - WIEN

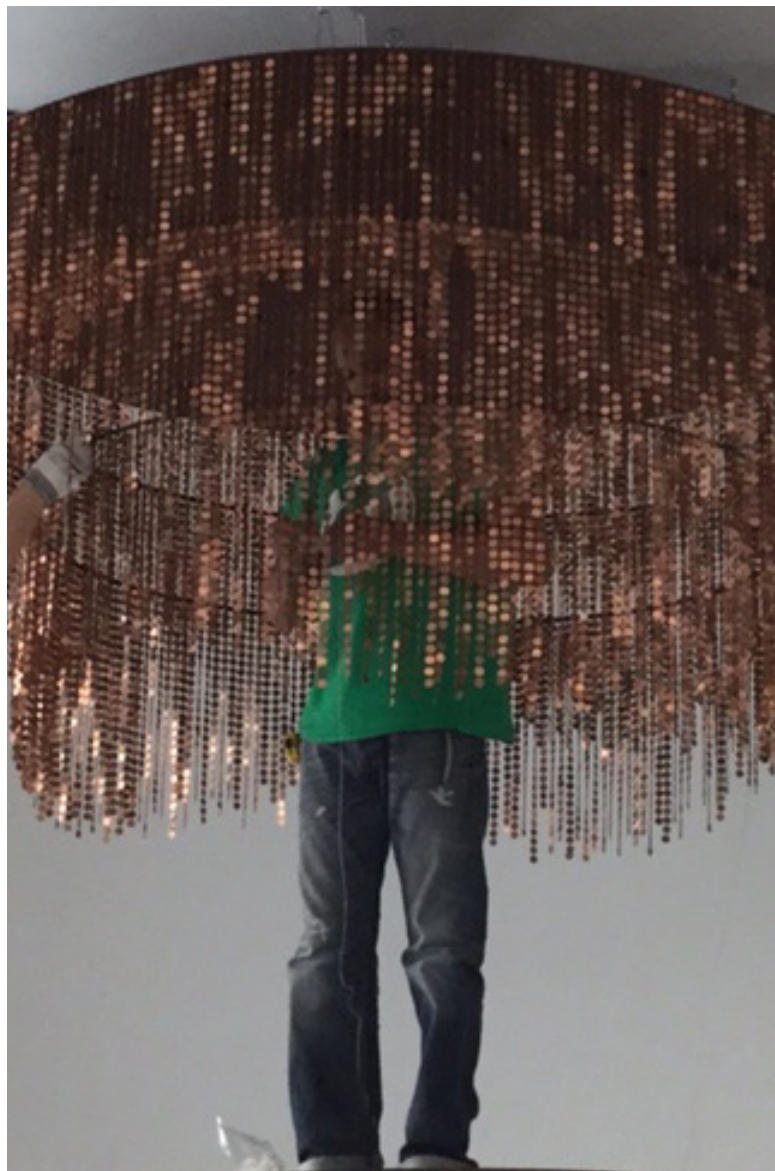
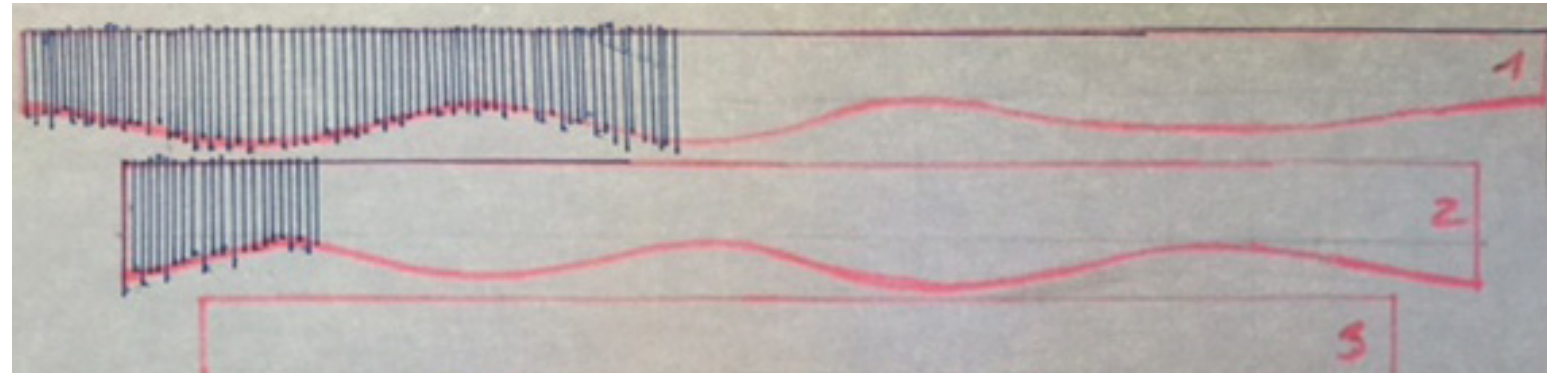
This lighting installation was created using 50.000 1 cents coins.

All coins are perforated and connected together by tiny metal rings.

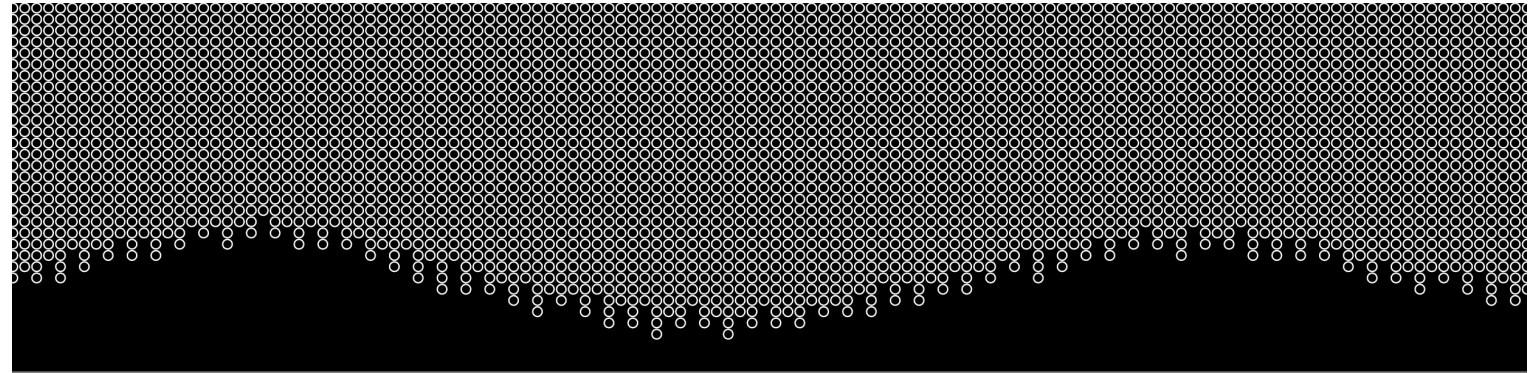
The whole installation is illuminated with 50 1W LED spots

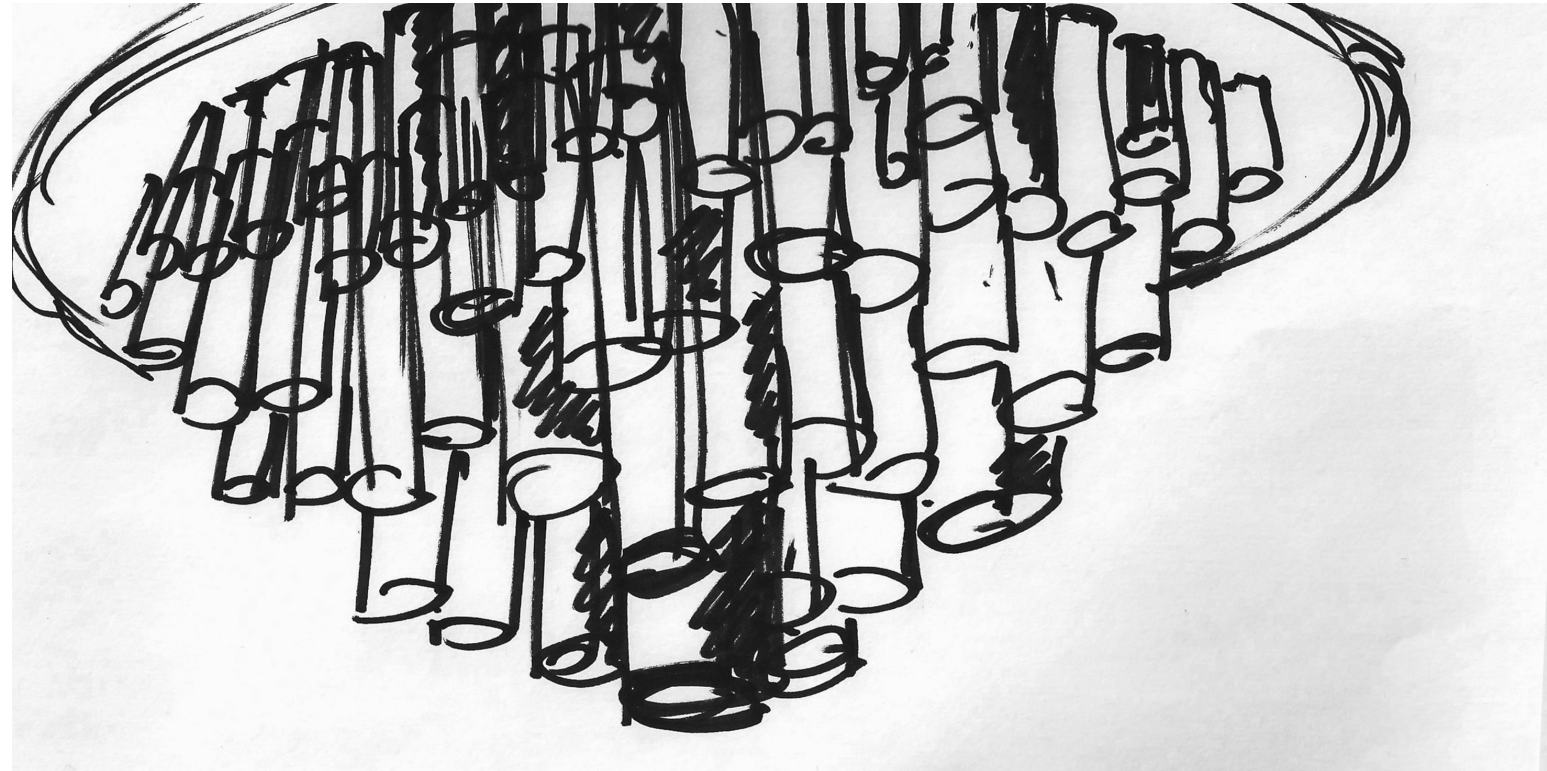
